Double Entries: Competitors/Crews/Coxes/Equipment may only enter one event per division.

Entry Limits: The Regatta Committee reserves the right to limit entries to particular events or to the regatta as a whole. Clubs are required to prioritise entries using the facilities provided within BROE. In the event that the regatta reaches its entry limits, entries will normally be accepted in priority order at the discretion of the organising committee.

Minimum Numbers: Changes due to insufficient entries will be notified via BROE. Club Secretaries should review proposed changes prior to the draw. Change of Status: Crews changing status on Saturday 4th should inform the Entries Secretary by 20:00 the same day.

Durham Regatta Championships (J18, IM2 & above Sunday): These events will begin with a time-trial over the course at the beginning of the division. Crews will then be seeded into 4 boat knockout events based on the results of the time-trial. There is no status points sub-classification and all crews should enter Elite/IM2 as per events offered above. This is part of the British Rowing "Pathfinder Events" programme. See Regatta website for more details. Inexperienced Crews: We suggest that all crews and competitors should have competed in at least two regattas earlier in the season.

Saturday Winners: Where possible the Sunday draw will allow space for Saturday winners in Open & Women's Novice/IM3 8+, 4+.

The Sunday J15 1x and J16 1x Open and Women's events (Sunday) will be the "Durham Regatta Junior Sculling Championships"

The College Championship Fours (Sunday) and College Maiden Novice Coxed Fours (Saturday) events are for Durham University College crews only.

Para/Rowability events will be offered depending on entries. We will combine classes using a handicap start system if insufficient entries are received in a particular para/rowability classification. Please contact us as soon as possible to discuss requirements.

In the event of cancellation or suspension of the regatta the committee will endeavour to refund 50% of entry fees, where crews have not raced, after unavoidable costs have been covered.

The regatta will be held under the Rules of British Rowing. The British Rowing Rules of Racing and Row Safe apply.
