Volunteer Information Sheet - 2021

Thank you very much for agreeing to volunteer at Durham Regatta. This booklet should provide you with key information to assist with your role and answer common queries from competitors or their supporting club officials

Timings

Racing commences at 08.00 on both days of the Regatta. Racing is scheduled to finish at 7pm on Saturday and 6.30 pm on Sunday

Please refer to the volunteer rota for shift times and assignment.

Unless advised otherwise, please report to Regatta Event Control – sited next to the Start (see map) in advance of your shift start time.

Prizes: collection by one crew member from table/gazebo adjacent to Regatta Control. Division 1 Races - 1 to 2.30 pm Division 2 Races - 6 to 7.30 pm

Car Parking

Volunteers are able to park free of charge in the Regatta Car Park, entrance halfway along Green Lane. There should be no Spectators in 2021.

Admission

There is no regatta enclosure for the 2021 Regatta. There will be no gates in operation.

Welfare

As this is an outdoor event, please ensure you dress for the weather. The weather can change suddenly so we would suggest bringing a sunhat / sun cream / sun glasses, and also waterproof clothes should the weather turn wet.

Water, soft drinks and a light snack (e.g. chocolate bar) will be available to all volunteers. We will try to distribute these to your volunteer positions

For volunteers working two or more shifts, a meal voucher can be collected – contact the Volunteer Co-ordinator

Events and Entertainment

There will be no bankside entertainment offered at the 2021 Regatta

Emergency Procedures

All volunteers are asked to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity or packages to Event Control.


